Crucial Crew

On Thursday 26th October 2017, Year 6 will be visiting Crucial Crew at the Lifewise Centre. This is an essential visit for all Year 6 children as it forms a key part of their PSHCE curriculum for the year.

The Lifewise centre is a life-size film set of a small town which is used to deliver safety messages to the public. It is operated in a unique partnership between South Yorkshire Fire & Rescue, South Yorkshire Police and South Yorkshire Safer Roads Partnership. It is home to members of the South Yorkshire Fire & Rescue (SYFR) and South Yorkshire Police community safety teams, allowing them to work in partnership under one roof.

The Crucial Crew experience is offered to all Year 6 school pupils in South Yorkshire. The children participate in a variety of scenarios in different areas of the set. Specialist officers equip the children with the skills and knowledge to make choices in everyday life in order to stay safe and away from criminal activity.

We will be departing by coach at 8:45am and returning to school at approximately 3:20pm.
